## Sylvain Dussort, Cuvée des Ormes 2015 Bourgogne 16.5

Quite restrained nose but a lovely citrus and greengage palate. This has the acid and snap that could almost be Sauvignon Blanc. Lovely fennel note on the finish. (RH)

## Sylvain Dussort, Vieilles Vignes 2015 Meursault 17

Smoky, broad and very sharply defined, with tart yet integrated acidity on the finish. Really nervy – yet has plenty of body to counter the angular structure. Very deftly done. (RH)

## Sylvain Dussort, Le Limozin 2015 Meursault 17.5

More smoky than their Vieilles Vignes, but has the same strongly acidic drive on the palate – yet with even more layers of fruit and length. Attractive meal and cereal quality. (RH)

Meal, oats, lemon and apple, mint and spice. Very good, this — exemplary for the region, not too fat or buttery, expert acidity. Delicious. (RH)
